

O sing to the LORD a new song (Psalm 98:1a).


Sit at Jesus' feet and listen to Him through His Word. Read your Bible daily.

FAMILY ACTIVITY: Create Your Own Garden

Design a garden that you can then tend. As you learn what helps your plants to thrive and flowers to bloom, you will grow in the skills needed to keep your garden healthy. Your garden can be planted indoors or outdoors depending on space. If you decide to create an indoor garden, read about growing houseplants and the things that are needed to keep them healthy—proper food, watering, light, and warmth. The same principles apply to outdoor gardens, just in different measure. Once you have purchased the houseplants, seedlings, or seeds you want to grow, decide how to arrange your plants so that they will thrive and best reflect God's glory. Then share your garden with others to enjoy. Tell them about the attributes of Christ you see reflected in your garden plants (His beauty, faithfulness, holiness, strength, care, etc.). As a family, discuss how caring for a garden is similar to caring for your heart, the place where Jesus abides with you!
