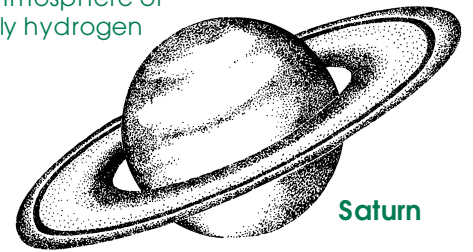

you didn't stop pedaling!

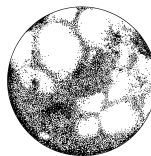

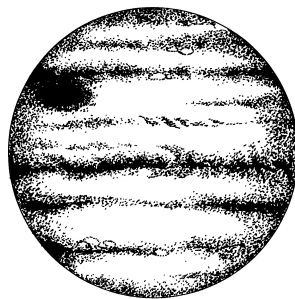

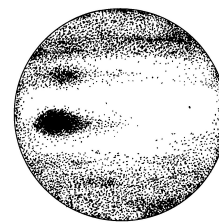

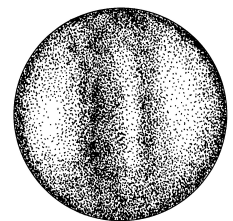
