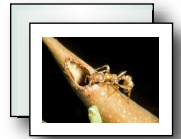
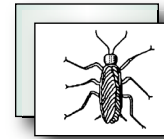

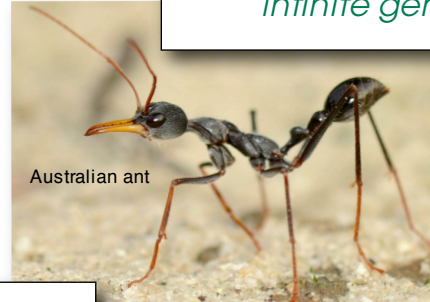

Ants possess an alien beauty—a dim reflection of *Christ's holy beauty*.

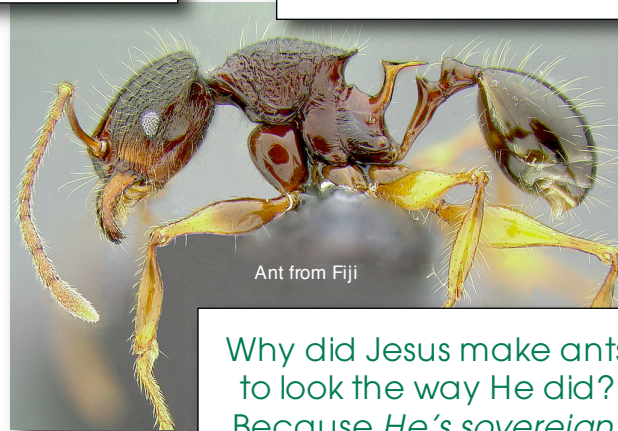
Ants need food, water, and shelter just like we do. They fully depend on their *sweet Creator*, who *faithfully provides* for them.

Why did Jesus make ants to look the way He did? Because *He's sovereign*.

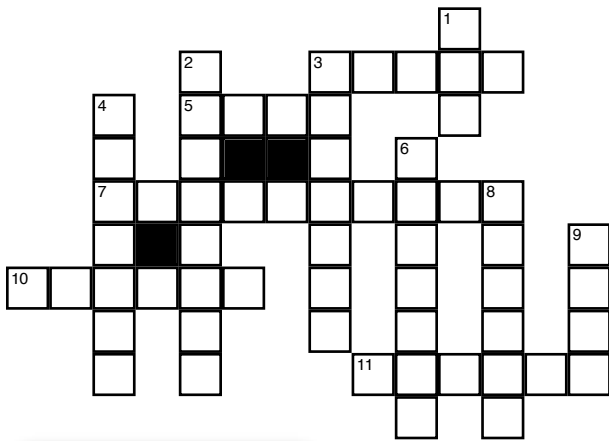
Ants imitate the Trinity by *working together as one* for God's glory (John 5:17).

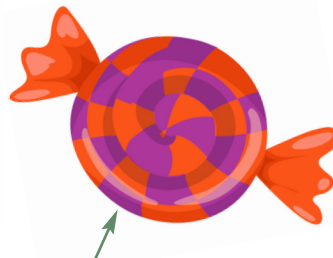
