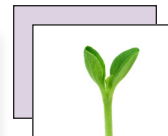

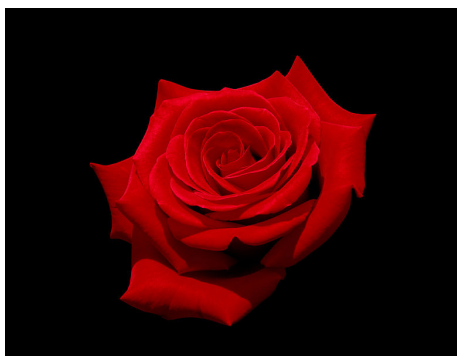
A coconut can be up to 18 inches (46 cm) in length.

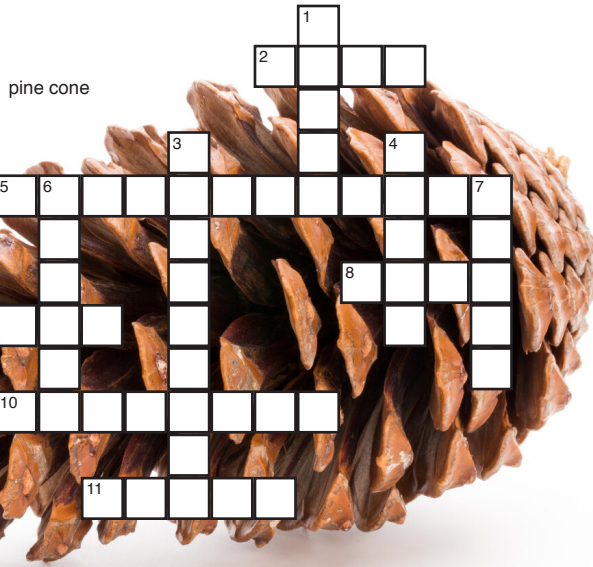
