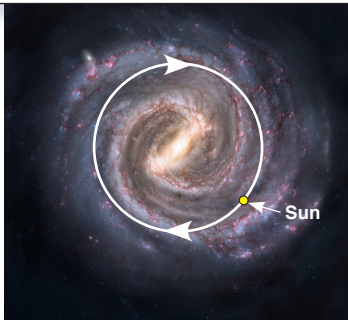


THE MOTIONS OF OBEDIENCE

God commands our sun to orbit the Milky Way Galaxy every 230 million years.



Halley's Comet regularly appears in the night sky every 76 years as it faithfully orbits the sun along an elliptical path.



The orbit of the earth around the sun is so precise that it can be stated down to a fraction of a day—365.2564 days.

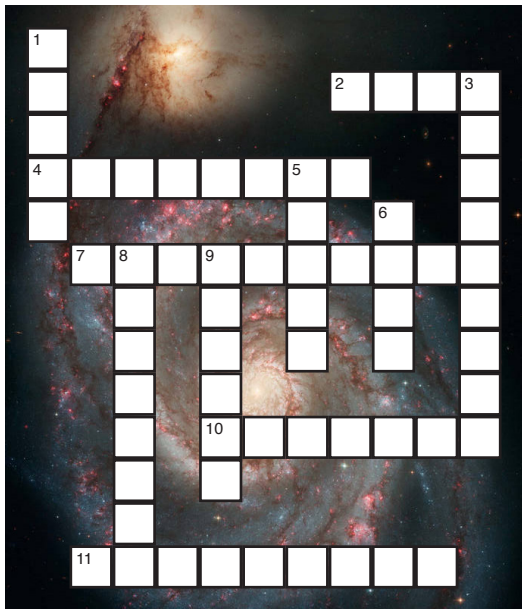


The moon orbits Earth every 27.32 days. The moon also rotates upon its own axis every 27.32 days. This means that the same side of the moon always faces Earth.



The reason that the orbit and rotation of the moon are exactly the same is that the moon perfectly obeys our Lord Jesus and is thus called “the faithful witness in the sky” (Psalm 89:37).

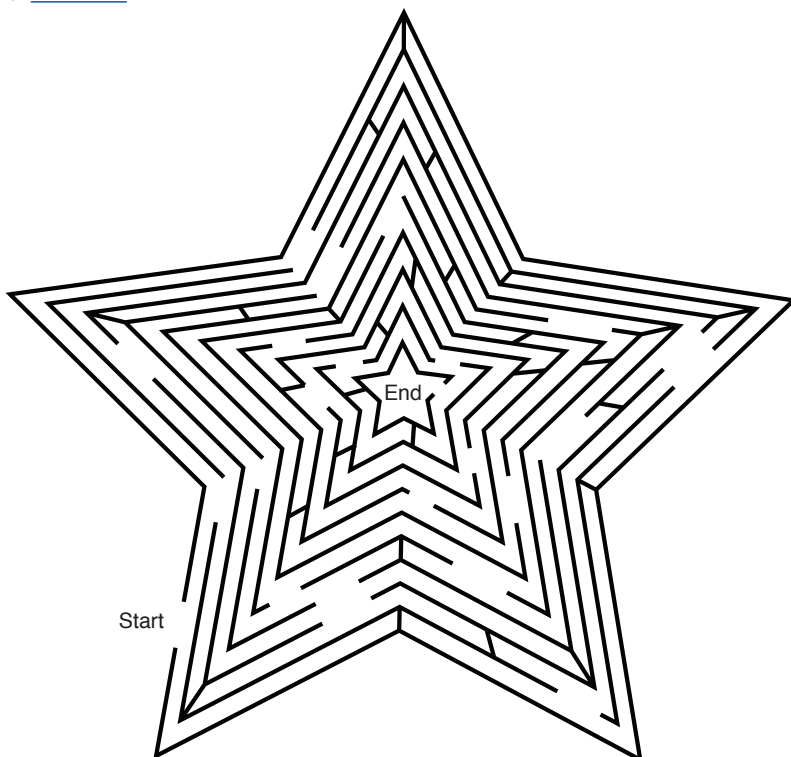
