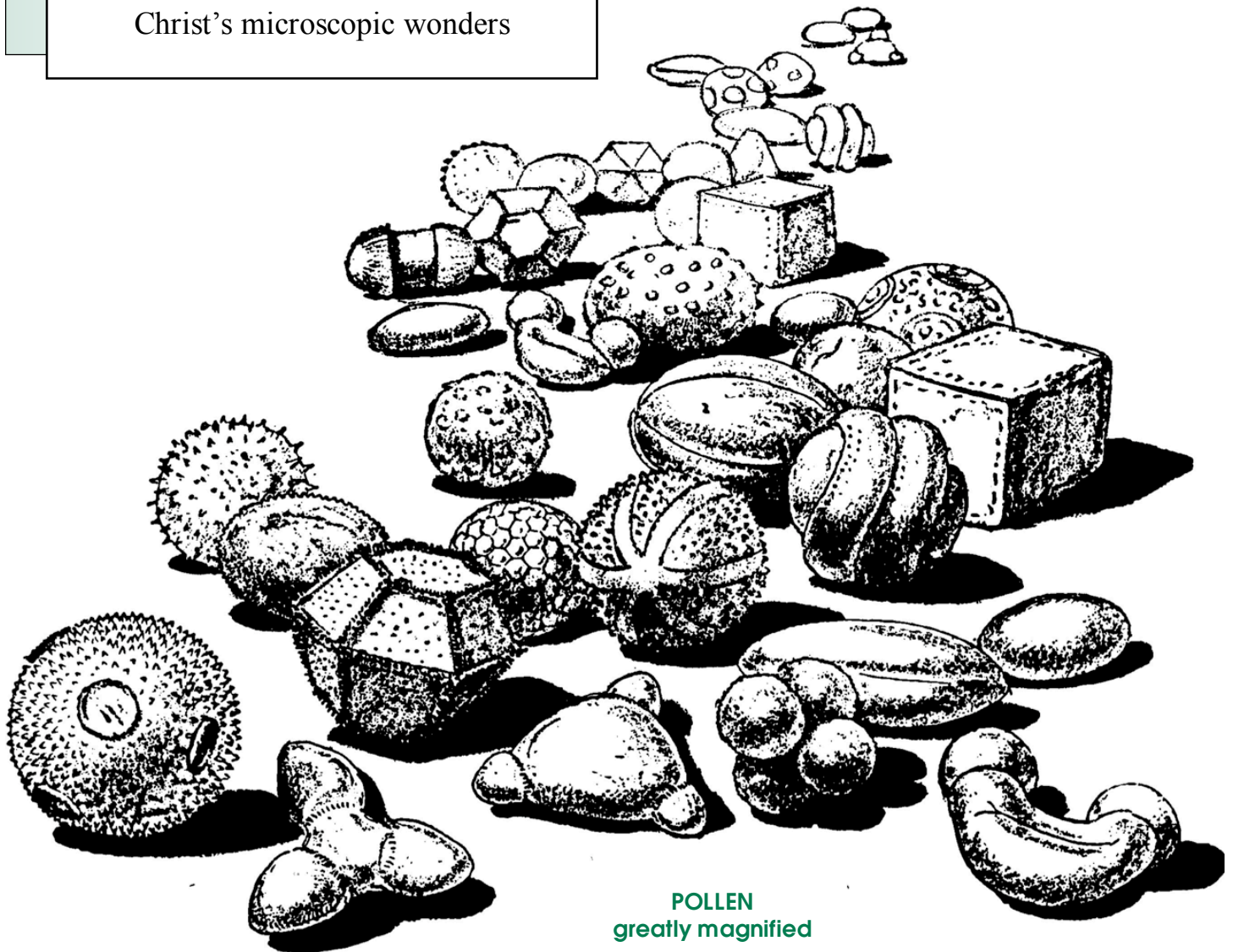


POLLEN SHAPES

Christ's microscopic wonders

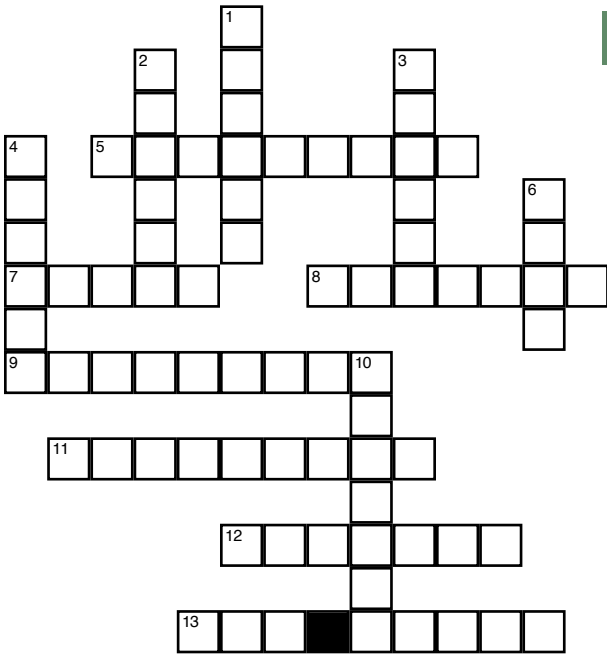
